

and that unconditionally guarantees the faithful performance, including any necessary repairs, of the conditions of an erosion and sediment control permit within a reasonable time and in the manner necessary to meet the minimum requirements of Chapter 19; to provide alternative methods of regulation of the construction of on-site storm water management facilities by allowing a building permit applicant or owner to post a certificate of guarantee from an organization that meets certain requirements and that unconditionally guarantees the faithful performance of the terms and conditions of the approved storm water management plan and the construction of the facility as are in the plan and in the provisions of Chapter 19; and to provide executive regulation authority; TO DELETE THE PROVISION THAT LETTERS OF CREDIT SHALL BE RENEWED ANNUALLY; AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL AND STYLISTIC CHANGES.

Chapter 16

Laws of Montgomery County 1985

AN ACT authorizing the issuance of bonds of Montgomery County, Maryland, in the principal amount not exceeding \$16,400,000 upon its full faith and credit for site acquisition and public buildings and the necessary furnishings and fixed permanent equipment therefor, prescribing the terms and conditions, by reference, upon which said bonds shall be issued and delivered and other incidental details with respect thereto, and providing for the application of the proceeds of such bonds and for the levy of unlimited ad valorem taxes for the payment of the principal and interest thereof.

Chapter 17

Laws of Montgomery County 1985

AN ACT authorizing the issuance of bonds of Montgomery County, Maryland, in the principal amount not exceeding \$29,585,000 upon its full faith and credit for financing construction, reconstruction, improvement and repair of public roads, streets, highways, sidewalks and storm drainage systems maintained and operated by or under the jurisdiction of the County, and prescribing the terms and conditions, by reference,
