OPEN MEETINGS ACT

4-202.

(b) "Public agency" includes:

(1) Any agency, assembly, authority, board, bureau, commission, committee, counsel, or department of St. Mary's County, except as provided in [§ 24] § 4-209 of this subtitle, including advisory and quasi-judicial agencies, supported in whole or in part by public funds or authorized to expend public funds; and

(2) Subcommittees and other subordinate units of the agencies above.

(a) All meetings of a public agency at which official action is taken regarding public business are open to the public, except as provided in [§ 25] § 4-210.

(b) Staff meetings of a public agency are open to the public.

4-204.

(b) All public agencies shall give supplemental written public notice of any special or rescheduled meeting, except as provided in [§ 19(d)] § 4-204(D), no later than 48 hours before the meeting. The notice shall include the agenda, date, time and place of the meeting.
