(c) (1) "Home health care" means any of the following services that are provided under the general direction of a licensed health professional practicing within the scope of their practice act:

- (i) Audiology and speech pathology[.];
- (ii) Dietary and nutritional services[.];
- (iii) Drug services[.];
- (iv) Home health aid[.];
- (v) Laboratory[.];
- (vi) Medical social services[.];
- (vii) Nursing[.];
- (viii) Occupational therapy[.];
- (ix) Physical therapy[.];
- (x) Provision of medically necessary sick room equipment and supplies.

(e) A nonregistered individual currently practicing as an environmental sanitarian may be registered with the Board if the individual:

(1) Graduates from an accredited college or university with:

(v) 1. A baccalaureate degree in a field other than environmental science or natural science; and
