(E) PLANS.

(1) THE SECRETARY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PLANNING OF ACTIVITIES, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES OF THE DEPARTMENT.

(2) THE SECRETARY MAY REVIEW, APPROVE, DISAPPROVE, OR MODIFY THE PLANS, PROPOSALS, AND PROJECTS OF THE UNITS IN THE DEPARTMENT.

In paragraph (1) of this subsection, the words "programs, and services" are added for clarity.

(F) REPORT TO GOVERNOR.

ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE SECRETARY SHALL SEND A REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR ON THE ACTIVITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT DURING THE PREVIOUS FISCAL YEAR.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection formerly appeared as Art. 78A, § 25.

The word "send" is substituted for the former word "file" to conform with similar provisions elsewhere in the Code.

(G) MISCELLANEOUS POWERS.

(1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE SECRETARY MAY EXERCISE ANY AUTHORITY THAT IS GRANTED TO ANY UNIT IN THE DEPARTMENT.

(2) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT AUTHORIZE THE SECRETARY TO EXERCISE ANY AUTHORITY GRANTED TO THE GENERAL PROFESSIONAL SERVICES SELECTION BOARD.
