4-208. NECESSARY AND PROPER POWERS.

THE DEPARTMENT HAS ANY POWER NECESSARY AND PROPER TO ACCOMPLISH A FUNCTION CONFERRED ON IT BY LAW OR DELEGATED TO IT OR REQUESTED OF IT BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS.
