- (3) A SPECIFIC SET OF PROCEDURES IS NECESSARY TO ENSURE THAT ALL UNITS OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT PERFORM REGULAR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR.
  - (B) DEPARTMENT TO ESTABLISH POLICIES AND STANDARDS.
- (1) THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES SHALL ESTABLISH GENERAL POLICIES AND STANDARDS FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS.
- (2) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31 OF EACH YEAR THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES SHALL SEND ANY CHANGES TO THESE GENERAL POLICIES AND STANDARDS TO:
  - (I) THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS;
- (II) THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND FISCAL PLANNING; AND
  - (III) THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE PLANNING.
  - (C) DEPARTMENT TO ESTABLISH, SUPERVISE, AND REVIEW.

THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:

- (1) ESTABLISH AND SUPERVISE A COMPREHENSIVE AND CONTINUING PROGRAM OF MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF ALL PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS; AND
- (2) REVIEW MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS TO THE EXTENT THAT ANY ENGINEERING QUESTION IS INVOLVED.
  - (D) UNITS OF STATE GOVERNMENT TO CARRY OUT PROGRAMS.

EACH UNIT OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT SHALL CARRY OUT A MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR PROGRAM FOR EACH PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE UNIT. IN CARRYING OUT THE PROGRAM, THE UNIT SHALL:

- (1) CONFORM TO THE POLICIES AND STANDARDS ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT; AND
  - (2) ALLOCATE SUFFICIENT FUNDS AND PERSONNEL.
