EACH CONSTRUCTION APPROPRIATION SHALL REQUIRE A STATE AGENCY, INCLUDING A DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD, TO OBTAIN A PROJECTION OF LIFE-CYCLE COSTS AND AN ENERGY CONSUMPTION ANALYSIS FROM THE DEPARTMENT.

4-806. ENERGY PERFORMANCE INDICES.

## (A) STANDARDS.

; SO THAT IT CAN AUDIT AND EVALUATE COMPETING DESIGN PROPOSALS, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SET STANDARDS FOR ENERGY PERFORMANCE INDICES.

## (B) USE.

AS EXPERIENCE DEVELOPS ON THE ENERGY PERFORMANCE ACHIEVED IN STATE BUILDINGS, THE ENERGY PERFORMANCE INDICES WILL SERVE AS A MEASURE OF BUILDING PERFORMANCE WITH RESPECT TO ENERGY CONSUMPTION.
