5-803. MEMBERSHIP.

- (A) COMPOSITION; APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS.
- (1) THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING 13 MEMBERS:
- (I) A SENATOR APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;
- (II) A MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE; AND
 - (III) 11 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.
- (2) A MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR MAY NOT HOLD A SALARIED STATE OFFICE.
- (3) AS FAR AS POSSIBLE, MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR SHALL BE SELECTED TO REFLECT DIFFERENT BROAD GEOGRAPHIC, ECONOMIC, AND SOCIAL INTERESTS IN THE STATE.
 - (B) TENURE; VACANCIES.
- (1) A MEMBER PPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE OR THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE APPOINTING AUTHORITY.
- (2) (I) THE TERM OF A MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR IS 4 YEARS AND BEGINS ON JUNE 1 IN THE YEAR IN WHICH THE MEMBER IS APPOINTED.
- (II) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (III) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
