

6-101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) BOARD.

"BOARD" MEANS THE BOARD OF REVENUE ESTIMATES.

(C) BUREAU.

"BUREAU" MEANS THE BUREAU OF REVENUE ESTIMATES.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added to avoid repetition of the full title "Bureau of Revenue Estimates".

(D) CHIEF.

"CHIEF" MEANS THE CHIEF OF THE BUREAU.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added to avoid repetition of former references such as "Chief of the Bureau".

6-102. BOARD OF REVENUE ESTIMATES.

(A) ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A BOARD OF REVENUE ESTIMATES.

(B) COMPOSITION.

THE BOARD CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING 3 EX OFFICIO MEMBERS:

(1) THE COMPTROLLER;

(2) THE TREASURER; AND

(3) THE SECRETARY OF BUDGET AND FISCAL PLANNING.

(C) EXECUTIVE SECRETARY.

THE CHIEF IS THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARY OF THE BOARD.
