

In subsection (a)(3) of this section, the former word "statistics" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the broad word "information".

In the introductory language of subsection (b) of this section, the former word "analyze" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the broad phrase "conduct studies".

6-105. REPORTS OF CHIEF.

(A) REQUIRED.

SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE OFFICE OF THE COMPTROLLER, THE CHIEF SHALL SUBMIT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY:

(1) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 31 OF EACH YEAR, A REPORT FOR THE PERIOD FROM JULY 1 TO DECEMBER 31, BOTH INCLUSIVE, OF THE PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR; AND

(2) ON OR BEFORE JULY 31 OF EACH YEAR, A REPORT FOR THE PERIOD FROM JANUARY 1 TO JUNE 30, BOTH INCLUSIVE, OF THE PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR.

(B) CONTENTS.

EACH REPORT UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL CONTAIN, FOR THE PERIOD THAT THE REPORT COVERS, AN ITEMIZED STATEMENT OF:

(1) THE STATE REVENUES THAT HAD BEEN ESTIMATED TO BE COLLECTED FROM ALL SOURCES;

(2) THE STATE REVENUES THAT WERE COLLECTED FROM THE SOURCES;

(3) ANY STATE REVENUES THAT WERE DUE FROM BUT NOT COLLECTED FROM THE SOURCES; AND

(4) ANY EXCESS STATE REVENUES THAT WERE COLLECTED FROM THE SOURCES.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 41, § 194(d).

Subsection (a) of this section is revised so that each item of that subsection provides for a report that covers a 6-month period. This revision allows concise reference to the applicable period and, thus, avoids an inconsistency as to the July report, which clearly
