 from Thomas Coolidge to her and recorded in the
 Land Records of said County and dated 21st day
 of May 1818 as by reference thereto will fully appear

 at the junction of the thumb ^{and five fingers} and a scar which seems to have been
 occasioned by a cut on the left side of the head that the said
 Cornwallis is a free man as appears by a manumission from
 Margaret Adams duly acknowledged and recorded in my office
 on the fifth day of May 1807
