the right arm occasioned by a cut. That the said Margaret
Tilghman is a free woman ^{of the County of Prince Georges} set free by Henry M. Hall
Esq. of the County of Prince Georges by manumission duly acknowledged and
Recorded in my office the thirtieth day of December 1814
Identified by Francis M. Hall in testimony &c.
Cut granted June 9th 1825

calls herself Jane Mitchell a bright mulatto girl
about 18 years old 5.1 in. high having a small
scar on her left elbow occasioned by a cut
is a free girl & became entitled to her freedom

Mitchell dated the 21 March 1818 & recorded
among the Land Records of said county
