entitled to her freedom by a Deed of Manumis-
sion from John B. Beanes bearing date the
nineteenth day of September 1809 & duly executed
and recorded in my office on the same day
The said woman was raised in the family of
William Clayton late of the County aforesaid
deceased with whose widow the said John B.
Beanes intermarried. I further certify that
a Negro Girl by the name of Lucy five years
old, about three feet six inches high of a dark
complexion, and having a prominent forehead
who is the daughter of the aforesaid woman
