On this 22^d day of June 1833 personally appears
before me the subscriber a Justice of the peace
in and for the County and State aforesaid, Richard
Gray of the County aforesaid, and makes Oath in the
Holy Evangelys of Almighty God that some time in
the year 1832 the former had this Deponent
cannot recollect, but believes it to have been in
the latter part of the month of December, he
lost his certificate of freedom granted him by the
Clerk of Precinct George County Court; that he has
since made a diligent search and inquiry for said
certificate but has not been able to recover it;
and the said Richard Gray further makes
Oath that the said certificate was not given to
any slave with a view of aiding or assisting him or her
in making his or her escape from his or her owner or
master.
