

Prince George's County - To wit:

On this 5th day of September 1842,
personally appeared James G. Webster,
before me, the subscriber, a Justice
of the peace of said County, and made
oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty
God that Negro Woman Elizabeth
Gainer, whose maiden name
was Elizabeth Lee, aged about
forty years; a fine foot two and a
half inches high; black complexion
has a scar on her right arm near
the bend thereof, and one on the
same arm near the wrist; and
another on her left hand near
the fore finger; and one on the
left arm near the bend thereof,
and has a scar on her left cheek.
— was set free on the 12th March,
1810 by her father Lancaster Lee,
and is now a free woman
to his knowledge.
