named Levisa aged about twenty six years
Now this is to certify that this is the Identical
girl or woman therein named under the follow
ing Identity that is to say she is about five feet
three inches and one quarter ^{high} she is fairly proportioned
rather a pleasant countenance with a good set
of teeth with a split or division in the nail of
the middle finger of the left hand caused by a
spring pin when packing Tobacco
