

if the Action miscarry by his Neglect whereby his Agent is damnified the Attorney that brought such Action shall make his Agent Satisfaction

2^d That all Declarations be filed with the Clerk within fifteen days after appearance Entered

3^d That all pleas be filed with the Clerk within five days before the C^t of Tryall which shall be the next after appearance Entered, except sufficient Reason to the contrary Shown to be allowed of by the C^t, and that all Issues be made up the first day of the C^t

4th That the Attorneys order their pleadings regularly first Plaintiff Attorney to open the Cause without Interruption and then Defendants Attorney to make his defence in the same manner the Pl^{ts} Attorney to have the Case in pleading and neither to use any unbecom^g Speeches each to other under the Penalty of two Shill^{ings} and Six pence to be paid by any Attorney Failing in any the afo^r Articles

5th In all Actions where the Fact is tryed by a Select Jury the Several & Respective Jurors are hereby warned that after they have agreed on their Verdict they keep the same Secret until the C^t demand their verdict Publicly under the Penalty of two Shill^{ings} & Six pence or according to the nature of the Matter as the C^t shall think fit

6th Ordered that all persons Sumoned as Jurors or Evidences to any certain C^t if the said C^t happen to be adjourned to some other day the persons so Sumoned are hereby required to make their Appearance at the said Adjourn'd C^t according to the nature of the Sumons without any farther notice from the Sheriff

7th That the Sheriff on every C^t day do return his Writts to the Clerk by nine of the Clock in the morning Under the penalty of One hundred pounds of Tobacco without some sufficient Reason allowed of by the C^t

8th Ordered that any person coming into C^t when sitting with their hats on their heads pay to the C^t over the Sum of one Shilling Sterling before the said hats be returned

9th That any person coming into C^t when sitting with their pipes in their mouths - Smoking shall pay the C^t for such Contempt one Shill^{ing} Sterling

10th That no person presume to speak in open C^t without leave first prayd & obtained under the penalty of one Shill^{ing} Sterling to be immediately paid before the person so offending departure out of C^t or sit half an hour in the Stocks

11th Ordered by this C^t that the Clerk Receive no pleas if they come not to his hand in due time as of the third Rule appears, and that such Attorney so neglecting shall pay the Damages and the C^t of Suite according to his Agents

12th Ordered that where the Defendant craves Oyer of the Pl^{ts} Tower, at the appearance C^t the Pl^{ts} Attorney shall file his warrant of Attorney with the Clerk, and produce the same when demanded or be fined at the discretion of the C^t if the Pl^{ts} be Non Suited

13th Ordered by this C^t that the Attorney of this C^t have their own Liberties as concerning Demurrors that is to have their own liberty whether they file the said Dem^{urrors} generally or Special
