I Commanded it was to the Sheriff of Kent County of twenty eight day off at November in the sixth yeare of the Reigne of her now Majesty Anne. ^{of} that he cause to come Samuel Goodin of said County if he should be found in his Day work that all Lawes be sett apart he be and appear before her said Maj^{ties} Justices at next Court to be held for said County at our Town and Port of Wester to answer unto all such things as should be then & there objected against him on her Majesty's behalfe, that he have then & there the said Writte

At which next Court was the twenty seventh day of January in the year aft the day of the return of said Writte came Edward Scott high Sheriff of said County & made returne thereof in these words thereon endorsed
made knowne to me Edw Scott Sher

But the said Court being adjourned until the twenty third day of March in the yeare aft then next following and all business be continued till then And now here at this day or the twenty third day of March aft in the yeare, aft came the said Samuel Goodin in his proper person and being called appears, according to Inditement which is followeth

Kent County of The Jurours for our Sovereign Lady the Queene that now is in Maryland for the body of said County upon their Oath doe present Samuel Goodin of said County Planter otherwise called Samuel Goodin of the same County for that he the said Samuel at South Passagrass hundred in said County within the Jurisdiction of this Court the feare of God before his eyes not having but being lead by a willfull and corrupt Inclination together with the Instigation of the Devil on the thirlyth day of August Anno 1707 did receive and per-lab wth divers Servants of and belonging unto Mary Pope of this County in taking & destroying one Lamb & Shoale being the proper goods of her the said Mary of the value of two hundred pounds
