All which said next C<sup>o</sup> was the twenty second day of Jan<sup>ry</sup> in the year  
aforesaid the day of the returne of said Writ came Edward Scott High Sheriff of said County  
& made returne thereof in these words thereon endorsed

non est Inventus p<sup>er</sup> me Edw Scott Sheriff

Commanded it was to the Sheriff of Kent County the twenty second day of Jan<sup>ry</sup>  
in the year last aforesaid that he cause to come Thomas Jones aforesaid if he that all Excuses  
be set apart that he appear before her said Maj<sup>ty</sup> Justice at the next C<sup>o</sup> to be held for  
said County at the Town & Port of Chester to answer unto all such things as shall be  
then there objected against him & that he have then show the said Writ<sup>ts</sup>

All which said next C<sup>o</sup> was the twenty third day of March in the year  
aforesaid the day of the returne of said Writ came Edward Scott High Sheriff of said  
County & made returne thereof in these words thereon endorsed

Epi Crispus p<sup>er</sup> me Edw Scott Sheriff

AND now here at this day viz the twenty third day of March in the aforesaid year  
the said Thomas Jones in his proper person and being called appears according  
to judgement

Upon motion of the aforesaid Thomas Jones to the Honorable C<sup>o</sup> that he  
might have Council assigned to him he being ignorant in such Cases - Therefore  
it is ordered by the C<sup>o</sup> here that Christopher Philipson Thomas Downe be  
assigned as Council for the aforesaid Thomas in this behalfe

The aforesaid Council of the aforesaid Thomas Jones prays the C<sup>o</sup> that the same may  
be postponed till tomorrow morning w<sup>ch</sup> was not granted by reason that they could  
show no reason for y<sup>e</sup> same but the judgement was as followeth

Kent County for the Jurors for our Sovereign Lady the Queen that now is for the body of said County upon  
in Maryland their Oath doo present Thomas Jones of said County otherwise called Thomas  
Jones of the same County for that he the said Thomas at Morgans Cocks Hundred in said County  
within the Jurisdiction of this C<sup>o</sup> the year of God before his eyes not having but being deluded  
and drawn by the flatterments & corrupt insinuations of the flesh & the suggestion of the Devil on  
the fifteenth day of Aug Anno Dom<sup>ini</sup> One thousand seven hundred & seven & divers times  
as well before as since hath doth live Incontinently doon in adultery w<sup>th</sup> a certaine Mary  
Tiller the wife of Patm Tiller late of the same County Carpenter to the great displeasure
