Kent County — To John Frogget of Kent County in the Province aforesd Carpenter
in Maryland otherwise called John Frogget of Kent County Carpenter was —
Sumoned to Answer unto Nathaniel Hynson of the same County
of a p^t that he render unto him the full & just sume of Six thou-
sand nine hundred eighty six pounds of good Sound Merchantable leaf
Tobacco in caske w^t to him he oozeth & from him unjustly detayn-
eth

and WHEREUPON the said Nathaniel by John Wellinger his att^t Lawyer saith that
whereas the said John Frogget on the thirteenth day of November in the year of our
Lord Christ one thousand Seaven hundred and Seven in Kent County aforesd within the
Jurisdiction of this C^t by his certame Bill or writing obligatory sealed to the said
John Frogget delivered and here in C^t produced whose date is the same day & year
aforesd did bind himselfe his heires Executors & Administrators to pay unto the aforesd
Nathaniel to his heires Executors Administrators or assignes the abovesaid sume of
Six thousand nine hundred eighty six pounds of Tobacco qualified as above said concomit
in said County yet never thelesse the said John Frogget alio often required C^t of afforme
of Six thousand nine hundred eighty six pounds of Tobacco according to the tenour of
same Bill unto the said Nathaniel hath not paid but the same to pay unto the said
Nathaniel by the said John Frogget hitherto hath denysed & gainsayed and as yett doth
deny and gainsay to the damage of the said Nathaniel nine Thousand pound of
Tobacco and therof the Brige Pule C^t Wellinger & quer Padger the 1st Dec^r 1708 —

AND now here at the said C^t vpon this twenty fifth day of March anno domini
1708 comesth the aforesd Nathaniel by his aforesd att^t and offereth himselfe against the said
John in the plea aforesd and the said John being solemnly called likewise comesth
