two hundred and nineteen pounds of Tobacco cost by him about his said suit in this
to be so he expended & by the Court here of this affent adjudged against the goods &
Chattells of the Said George Lumley have an Attachment, he the Said Peregrine
Browne giving Securitie Answering to all of Assembly

WHEREUPON cometh into Court Michael Earle & becomes Security for
the aforesd Peregrine Browne that if the Said Dost shall in a year and day from
awarding the sume of Attachment come into Court made it appeare that the said
Peregrine hath beene & is satisfied the Demand aforesd or shall otherwise in Court
discomfit or ban the said Peregrine of the sume or any part thereof the said
Peregrine shall make Restitution of the goods & Chattells so attached & condem-
ned on the value thereof &
