AND now here at the Said Court this twenty fifth day of March aforesaid Anno 1708 cometh the Said Peregrine Browne by Michael Earle his Attorney & prayeth the Court that he may have Judgment for an Attachment against the Goods and Chattells of the aforesaid George Lumley for the aforesaid Sum of One thousand Seven hundred and ten pounds of Tobacco the debt aforesaid & also the Cost thereon amounting to 0 = 0 = Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the Said Peregrine Browne for the aforesaid Sum of One thousand Seven hundred and ten pounds of Tobacco qualified as aforesaid Debt & also the Sum of two hundred and nineteen pounds of Tobacco cost by him about his Suit in this Cause halfe expended & by the Court here of this aforesaid adjudged against the goods & Chattells of the Said George Lumley have an Attachment, he the Said Peregrine Browne giving Security according to Act of Assembly &c

Whereupon cometh into Court Michael Earle & prays the Security for the aforesaid Peregrine Browne that if the Said Debt shall in a year and day from awarding the Said Attachment come in & make it appear that he the Said Peregrine hath been & is satisfied the Demand aforesaid or shall otherwise in full discharge or can the Said Peregrine of the Sum or any part thereof he the Said Peregrine shall make Restitution of the goods & Chattells so attached & condemned or the value thereof &c

All which said writ &c the twenty third day of March in the year aforesaid the day of the return of said writ came Edward Scott high Sheriff of Said County & made returne thereof in this words thereon Endorsed viz
