Ready to be produced but the said Deft George Lumley hath not paid nor any wise made Satisfaction of the same to the said Mich Earle for w. the said Mich pray Judgment for an Attachment according to Law

At W. now here at the said &c. on this twenty fifth day of March a. d. Anno Domini 1708 cometh the said Michael Earle in his proper person & prays the &c. that he may have Judgment for an Attachment against the goods & Chattels of the afd George Lumley for the afd Sum of Three Thousand & thirty one pounds of Tobacco Debt &c. Thereon accruing &c. Therefore it is Considered by the &c. here that the said Michael Earle for the afd Sum of Three thousand & thirty one pounds of Tobacco Debt and also the Sum of two hundred & fourteen pounds of Tobacco cost by him about his Suite in this behalfe expended &c. here of his assent adjudged against the Goods and Chattels of the said George Lumley have an Attachment; he the said Michael Earle giving Security according to Act of Assembly &c.

Wherupon cometh in &c. Edward Scott of this County &c. cometh Security for the afd Michael Earle that if the said Deft shall within a year & day from a warding of said Attachment come in and appear to the original Action & make it appear that he the said Michael Earle hath been & is paid of Demand of a Third otherwise in &c. discount or barr the said Michael of the Sum or any part thereof he the said Michael shall make Restitution of the goods & Chattels soe attached & condemned or the value thereof &c.
