the 10th May 1707 to pay six hundred pounds of Tobacco qualified as per said Order ready to be produced to said Order the said Thomas accepted payable to said Arthur for to the said said Arthur prays an Attachment according to Law

Now here at the Court viz this twenty fifth day of March a^d Anno Dom 1708 cometh the P^o Arthur Miller by Christopher Philipson his Attorney prays the Court that he may have Judgment for an Attachment against the goods Chattels of the a^d Thomas Lovely for the a^d sum of six hundred pounds of Tobacco Damages &c thereon accrued viz 0-0-0. Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the P^o Arthur Miller for the a^d sum of six hundred pounds of Tobacco Damages and also the sum of two hundred & six pounds of Tobacco cost by him about his sale in this behalf &c &c &c &c &c here of his a^d judgment against the goods Chattels of the said Thomas Lovely have an Attachment by the said Arthur Miller giving Security according to Act of Assembly &c

Whereupon cometh into Court Daniel Boone of said County &c to come with Security for the a^d Arthur Miller that if the said Debt shall be in any year day from a signing of same attachment coming app^o to original Queen make it app^o that he by P^o Arthur hath done is satisfied & demand a^d or shall otherwise in Court be exempt or bare of P^o Arthur of the sum or any part thereof he the said Arthur shall make restitution of the goods Chattels so attached and condemned or the value thereof &c
