That, Whereas at a Co<sup>ts</sup> held for s<sup>ay</sup> County at y<sup>e</sup> Co<sup>ts</sup> house on Chester River on y<sup>e</sup>  
fifteenth day of Feb<sup>r</sup> y<sup>e</sup> was in y<sup>e</sup> year of our Lord one thousand six hundred  
ninety seven W<sup>ill</sup> Bentley obtained a Judgm<sup>t</sup> ag. Tho<sup>s</sup> Jow a sum<sup>m</sup>  
of two thousand two hundred pounds of Tob<sup>o</sup>: according to Act of Assembly as y<sup>e</sup>  
Sum<sup>m</sup> of two hundred fifty & five pounds of Tob<sup>o</sup>: costs of Suite and for that satisfaction  
still remains to be made, by good & lawful Men of his Baywick he make known

of s<sup>ay</sup> Writte came Edw<sup>d</sup> Scott high Sher<sup>of</sup> of s<sup>ay</sup> County and made returne thereof in these words

exactly requirith If mo<sup>r</sup> Edw<sup>d</sup> Scott Sher<sup>of</sup>

At w<sup>ch</sup> s<sup>ay</sup> Co<sup>ts</sup> came y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>ay</sup> W<sup>ill</sup> Bentley by Christopher Philipson his Att<sup>y</sup> and offered  
himself ag<sup>t</sup> y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>ay</sup> Tho<sup>s</sup> Jow in y<sup>e</sup> plea aft<sup>r</sup>. And y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>ay</sup> Tho<sup>s</sup> Jow by Mich<sup>l</sup> Earle his  
Att<sup>y</sup> appeared and prayed liberty to impare until y<sup>e</sup> next Co<sup>ts</sup> W<sup>ch</sup> to him was  
granted The same day was given to y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>ay</sup> W<sup>ill</sup> Bentley there also  
After w<sup>ch</sup> y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>ay</sup> County Co<sup>ts</sup> was adjourned from y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>ay</sup> Co<sup>ts</sup> house aft<sup>r</sup> on Chester River
