Dominick Kenlagh Commanded it was to the Sher of Kent County the Twenty-  
Peter Brett. - - - - -  
Seaventh day of January in the Sixth year of the Reigne  
of her now Majestie Anne &c. that he take the Peter Brett  
of Kent County a 1<sup>st</sup> Gent. if he should be found in his  
Bayliffe to him safe keepe for that he have his body before her said Majesties  
justices at the next C. to be held for said County at the Town & Port of Chelster to  
Answer unto Dominick Kenlagh of said County Plaintiff of a plea of Trespass upon  
the Case and that he have them there the said Writ &c.

At which next C. the Twentieth third day of March in the Seventh year  
of her now Majesties Reigne the day of Return of said Writ came Edward Scott High  
Sher of said County & made Return thereof in these words therein Endorsed  
Epi. Edm. Scott Sher

AND a Declaration being filed when said Writ should forth & a Copy  
thereof Perced therewith according to Act of Assembly in that case made was as  
followeth Viz.

Kent County of Peter Brett of Kent County a 1<sup>st</sup> Gent. was attached to Answer unto  
in Maryland of Dominick Kenlagh of said County Plaintiff of a plea of Trespass upon  
the Case

AND Whereupon of said Dominick by Christopher Pulifson his Attorney Complaind for  
that whereas the afo<sup>r</sup> Peter of Thurneth day of June Anno Domini 1707 at Kent County  
afo<sup>r</sup> within of Jurisdiction of this Court in Consideration of a Petition bargain or Swap  
made between them the said Peter and Dominick of two Korps belonging to them the  
said Peter & Dominick, he the said Peter became then & thereby justly indebted unto  
him the said Dominick the Summe of Six hundred pounds of Tobacco And for pay-  
ment thereof did make a note or bill upon a Petition George Lumley of Kent County  
a 1<sup>st</sup> Gent. the Tenor whereof is as followeth Viz. Like the 30. 1707 M: Lumley pray  
pay unto Dom Kenlagh or ord the Summe of Six hundred pounds of Tobacco and this  
my note is: his Receipt shall oblige me to give you in your bill which is all  
from yo<sup>r</sup> friend to serve you Peter Brett And in Execution thereof did upon him-  
self a summe and unto the said Dominick then & there faithfully Promise that if  
of said George should refuse to accept and pay of said Note that then he the said  
Peter when the same afterwards required the afo<sup>r</sup> Summe of Six hundred pounds of  
Tobacco unto of said Dominick would well & faithfully pay & Content - And the afo<sup>r</sup>  
Dominick in fact sayd that afo<sup>r</sup>wards viz upon the first day of August then  
next following at Kent County afo<sup>r</sup> within the Jurisdiction of this Court he the said  
Dominick presented the said note unto the said George in ord for acceptance &  
payment as abovesaid is: said George utterly refused both to accept & pay the said  
And also upon the 23. day of February then next following viz in the  
year
