Upon motion to this worshipful Court if fine might be taken ^{ORDERED} by the Court here that if the said Sarah can bring a good substantial house keeper & dweller in this County to pay her fine then the same to be taken and the assumption to be entered

Mr. William Worell assumes to pay six hundred pounds of fine for the fine of the said Sarah Beelle. Jam. Smith

John Hamlin son to Benjamin Hamlin being an orphan of this County comes into open Court ^{ORDERED} by the Court here that James Tilton who is the executor of Humphrey Tilton late of the same County decease the said Humphrey Tilton in his lifetime being guardian to the said John Hamlin: ^{it is} ORDERED by the Court here that James Tilton the ex. as a ^{part} deliver up to the said Philip Loadin the estate of the said John being seven pounds thirteen shillings and nine pence sterlings and when the same is delivered to the said Philip the thousand ^{following} to give security for the payment of the same when demanded if at age according to act of a Assembly in that case made & provided. ^{the} said Philip doth oblige himself at his own cost & charge to earn Joseph ^{the} Jam. Smith

Upon motion of Michael Charles Carter of the Indictments to this Court that Elizabeth Miller may enter into recognizance with good security for her appearance at the next Court of good behaviour in the mean time. ORDERED that the said Elizabeth Miller enter into recognizance with two good security for her appearance at the next Court of good behaviour

AND the said Elizabeth Miller comes into Court & acknowledges the her selfe justly indebted unto our Sovereign Lady Queen Anne her heirs & Successors in the full & just sum of ten pounds sterlings to be levied upon her goods & Chattels Lands and ^{Penalties}
