the value of two thousand Pounds hundred pounds of Tobacco & when he had the same pro-  
Attached or any part thereof the same in his Custody before that he had the same pro-  
Said Majesties Justices at the next C<sup>t</sup> to be held for said County at the Towne of  
Caster to satisfie unto John Hawkins Jun<sup>r</sup> as well the summe of One thousand  
Eight hundred & fifty pounds of Tobacco upon Judgment obtained against  
the said Alexander Graves by the said Justices in our said C<sup>t</sup> on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of this  
Instant March whereof he is Convict as appears upon Record together with the summe  
of two hundred & Twenty two pounds of Tobacco & of Time in this behalfe appendid as  
also together with the additional C<sup>t</sup> thereon curwinge that by good & Lawfull men  
of his Baylwick he make knowne unto the party or parties in whose hands he make the  
same Attachment as afo<sup>r</sup> that he shal or they be and aby before her Majesties Justices  
at the time and place assyed to this cause if any they shal have why the same ought  
not to be condemned for the rate & reason of the debt & also herof he was not to fail  
at his pyle & that he have the names of the persons before whom he shal make the  
same Attachment as afo<sup>r</sup> & how he shal recoule this whiche he make knowne unto the  
said Majesties at y<sup>e</sup> time place assyed & that he have there thence said witness<sup>e</sup>

All Whiche said next C<sup>t</sup> vñ the Twenty Second day of June in the years af<sup>r</sup> the  
day of Returnes of said Writt came Edward Scott Esq<sup>r</sup> Sheriff of said County and made return  
thereof in these words theron subscribed Viz<sup>r</sup>

The se<sup>r</sup> are to certifie to the Justices within mentioned that I haue attache  
of the proper goods and Chattells of Alexander Graves One horse at the value of  
One thousand pounds of Tobacco and made the same knowne before Mr Michael  
Miller and in Benjamin Recaud two good and Lawfull men of my Baylwick  
and haue attache One thousand four hundred and forty pounds of Tobacco as  
the goods of the said Graves and made the same knowne before John Davis &  
John Robinson two good and Lawfull men of my Baylwick as the within esd<sup>r</sup>

AND now come the afo<sup>r</sup> John Hawkins Jun<sup>r</sup> & John Wellerer his attorney  
and moveth the C<sup>t</sup> here for Condemnation of the Horse and One Thousand four  
hundred and forty pounds of Tobacco as afo<sup>r</sup> attache and no manner of Person  
appearing to give any cause to the contrary, but one Lawrence Safford being an  
hired Servant to the afo<sup>r</sup> Alexander Graves when the Tobacco as afo<sup>r</sup> mentioned was  
attache was made, and the said Alexander Graves not payning his full wages the  
said Lawrence Safford coming in now at this present C<sup>t</sup> by way of Petition that he  
might have what the afo<sup>r</sup> Alexander was indebted to him on ballance of his wag;  
whiche the said Lawrence makes appear upon Oath is Six hundred and Twenty  
pounds of Tobacco whiche the afo<sup>r</sup> Hawkis is not fit to condemn as also the foy
