of two hundred & twenty two pounds of Tobacco C^t of fine in this behalf depending as
also together with the additional C^t thereon & saying that by good & Lawfull means
of his Day Week he make knowne unto the party or parties in whose hands he make the
same Attachment as a^{ft} that he sh^d or they be and app^r before her^{ty} Majesties Justices
at the time and place a^{ft} to this cause if any they should have why the same ought
not to be condemned for the satisfaction of the debt & C^t a^{ft} hereof he was not to give
at his will & that he had the names of the persons before whom he should make the
same Attachment as a^{ft} & how he should execute this writ he make knowne unto the
said Majesties at any time & place a^{ft} that he had then the said writ & C^t

All which said writ & C^t on the twenty second day of June in the year a^{ft} the
day of Return of said writ came Edward Scott High Sher^{iff} of said County and made return

the goods of the said Graves and made the same knowne before John Davis &
John Robinson two good and Lawfull men of my Day Week as the within Exalteth

AND now Cometh the a^{ft} John Hawkins Jun^r by John Wellinger his attorney,
and moveth the C^t there for Condemnation of the Horse and One thousand four
hundred and fifty pounds of Tobacco as a^{ft} Attached and noo manner of Person
appearing to shew any cause to the contrary, but one Lawrence Stafford being con-
sidered Servant to the a^{ft} Alexander Graves when the Tobacco as a^{ft} mentioned was
Attached was made, and the said Alexander Graves not paying his full wages the
said Lawrence Stafford coming in now at this s^{es}ion C^t by way of Plea that he
might have what the a^{ft} Alexander was indebted to him on Ballance of his wages
which the said Lawrence makes appears upon Oath is Six hundred and Twenty
pounds of Tobacco which the C^t think's not fitt to Condemn as also the s^{es}ion
