At which said next Court the Twenty second day of June in the year aforesaid the day of the Return of Writs James Edward Scott Esq Sheriff of said County made return thereof in these words thereon endorsed

AND the said Defts by their Attorney Philipson then attly appears Date the said 23<sup>rd</sup> not pleading any Cause of Action the said Defts by their attly moves the Court for a non Suite which was granted = = = Therefore it is Considered by the Court on this Twenty third day of June Anno Domini 1708 that the said George Browning take nothing by his Writ aforesaid but for his false Damour he be in money and the said Joseph Dulock Francis Bellows & Margret his wife good thereof without day & it is also Considered the same day & year aforesaid that the said Joseph Dulock & Francis Bellows Margret his wife in their Capacities aforesaid recover against the said George Browning of Sum of fifty pounds of Tobacco for his non Suite & also the sum of One hundred & fifty pounds of Tobacco costs by of said Executors about the same in this behalf expended & by the Court hereof his assent adjudged amounting in the whole to the sum of two hundred pounds of Tobacco and that the said Executors have their Execution
