And Whereas of said William by Christopher Phillipson his attorney complain
for that whereas of a f^d John of 25th day of March anno Dom 1708 at Kent County
aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this C^c In Consideration that the aforesaid William
had then and there and at the Request of him the said John paid
unto a certaine Daniel Mullican for the use of said John the summe of
1640⁰ of Tobacco did upon himself a summe and unto the said William then and there
faithfully promise that he the said John the aforesaid summe of 1640⁰ of Tobacco when these
unto required would and truly pay & content Never the less of a f^d John his promise
a sumption a f^d in form aforesaid not regarding of a f^d summe of 1640⁰ of Tobacco unto
the said William he hath not paid altho afterwards vrs upon y^e 19th day of May anno Dom
1708 at Kent County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of the said William thereto
required but of same to him to pay hath denied & sayd doth deny & gainsay whereupon he
sayth he is worse damage hath to the value of three thousand pounds of Tobacco
of this his bringe Rate &c

And now here at the said C^c v^r the 23rd day of June in this present year comes w^t a f^d William
by Christopher Phillipson his attorney & thereth himself against the said John Browning
in y^e Plea aforesaid the said John being solemnly called Likewise cometh

Whereupon the said William by his aforesaid attorney cometh y^e to say that the said John
may give spec^d Dayle to the said Attorney of him the said William ORDERED by the C^c
here that the said John Browning the Doffe aforesaid give spec^d Dayle to the auon aforesaid against
him

After which George Browning of said County herein & cometh to com^d Dayle
doth undertake for the said John Browning the payment of all Damages & Costs if it
shall happen that the said William Harris shall obtain Judgment against the said
