William Harris Commanded it was to the Sher of Kent County the Twinty fifth
day of March in the Seaventh year of the Reigne of our now
Majestie Queen Anne. That he take John Browning of Kent County

soe that he have his body before her said Majesties Justices at the next Court to be held at the
Court house at the Towne of Chichester in said County to answer unto William Harris of
said County Gent of a plea of Trespass upon the Case and that hee have then & there the

At which said next Court the Twinty second day of June in the year aforesaid
day of Return of said Writt came Edward Scott Esq. Sher of said County & made a Return
thereof in these words thereon endorsed vizt Capi Corpus pro me Edward Scott Sher

AND a Deed being filed when said Writt issued for the Copy thereof to be
therewith according to Act of Parliament in that behalf made was as followeth vizt
Kent County of John Browning of Kent County aforesaid Planted was attached to answer
unto William Harris of said County Gent of a plea of Trespass upon
the Case

AND Whereupon of said William by Christopher Phillipson his attly Complain
for that whereas of aforesaid John of 25th day of March Anno Dom 1708 at Kent County
aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court In CONSIDERATION that the aforesaid William
had then and there and at the Espe Justice request of him the said John paid
unto a certaine Daniel Mullican for the use of said John the full Just Summe of
1640 of Tobacco did upon himselfe a Summe and unto the said William then and there
faithfully promise that hee the said John the aforesaid Summe of 1640 of Tobacco when there
unto required would well & truly pay & content Never the less of aforesaid John his promise
of Sumption aforesaid in form aforesaid made not regarding of aforesaid Summe of 1640 of Tobacco unto
of said William he hath not paid altho afterwards vizt upon 19th day of May Anno Dom
1708 at Kent County aforesaid within of Jurisdiction aforesaid he hath been by the said William thereunto
required but of said John to him to pay hath denyed & coyld do the day & garnish whereupon he
sayth he is worse & damage hath to the value of three thousand pounds of Tobacco
of this he brings into &c

AND now here at the said Court the 23rd day of June 1708 comes of aforesaid William
by Christopher Phillipson his aforesaid attly & Hereth himselfe against the said John Browning
in of Neare aforesaid the said John being solemnly called Likewise Cometh

Whereupon the said William by his aforesaid attly & moveth of Court that the said John
may give spe^{cial} Dayle to the said Queen of him the said William ordered by the Court
here that the said John Browning the doth aforesaid give spe^{cial} Dayle to the Queen aforesaid against
him

Affidavit which George Browning of said County here in Court Cometh & cometh by

shall happen that the said William Harris shall obtaine Judgment against the said
