Robert Roberts  
 Commanded it was to the Sheriff of Kent County the Twenty fourth  
 day of September in the sixth year of the Reigne of her now May  
 Maie that he take William Comegys of Kent County a Justice  
 if he should be found in his Dayliwk & from that he keep soe that hee have his body be fore  
 her said Maie Justice at the next Court to be held at the Towne of Queter in said County  
 to answer unto Robert Roberts late of said County Gloo of a plea of Trespass upon the  
 Case and that he have thine there the said writ &c

All which said next Court viz the Twenty sixth day of November in the year aforesaid  
 day of the Return of said writ came Edward Scott High Sheriff of said County and made  
 Return thereof in these words thereon endorsed viz

And the said William Comegys being personally called came to the Court by Michael Parke  
 his atty in law the Court sure that the said Robert may give bail to pay cost if demanded  
 Ordered that the said Robert Roberts doe give bail to pay cost of the said William  
 should obtaine a non Suite against the said Robert Roberts Whereupon Christopher  
 Philippon becomes bail & doth undertake for the said Robert the payment of all Costs of the  
 said Robert shall be non Suted & pay not the Costs

After which the said William by Michael Parke his attorney appeared and prayed  
 Liberty thereof to departe until the next Court to him was granted the same day  
 was given the Court likewise

All which said next Court viz the Twenty eighth day of November in the year  
 aforesaid the said Cause was continued until the then next Court

All which said next Court viz the Twenty seventh day of January in the year aforesaid  
 the said Cause was adjourned until the next ensuing Court

All which said next Court viz the Twenty third day of March in the seventh year of her  
 now Majesties Reigne the said Cause was continued until the then next Court

All which said next Court viz the Twenty fourth day of June in the same year of her  
 said Maie Reigne Anno Domini 1708 the said Cause standing for Tryall came the said  
 Court by Christopher Philippon his atty and the said Deft by his atty and the Court  
 by his said atty declared on

Kent County of William Comegys of Kent County a Justice was attached to answer unto Robert  
 late of said County Gloo of a plea of Trespass upon the Case

All to hereupon the said Robert by Christopher Philippon his attorney complains for that whereas  
 the aforesaid William the first day of March Anno Domini 1705 at Kent County a Justice within the  
 Jurisdiction of this Court in Consideration that the aforesaid Robert had at the spee Justice  
 request of him the said William sold and Delivered several goods to him the said Will  
 and at the spee Justice request done several Services for him the said William  
 viz at the time of sale a sum amounting to the sum of Three and Twenty Shillings  
 pence
