 hundred pounds of Tobacco and some debt whereof he is content as appears upon  
 Record as aforesaid together with the Sum of Two hundred & four pounds of Tobacco  
 & of Suite and for that Reason hath not thereupon yett issued by the foresaid  
 Commandment that by good and Lawfull men of his Baywick he makes knowne  
 unto the Said Thomas Doer that he be and apper before our Justice of our next  
 County Court to be held at our Court house at the Towne of Chester in said County on  
 the fourth Tuesday in January then next ensuing to show cause if any he have why  
 Execution should not issue forth against him for the debt & for the Judgment  
 as is specified And how he should execute that Writt he was to make knowne  
 to the Justice of our said Court at the day & place aforesaid and that he hold them  
 there the said Writt

All which said Court viz the fourth Tuesday in January viz the Twenty Seventh  
 day of said Month in the year of the said same Court was adjourned until the  
 next ensuing Court in Course and all Writts and process returnable to this Court remaine  
 in the hands of the Sheriffe of this County until the then next Court viz the said Court  
 at for viz the Twenty third day of March in the Seventh year of the Reigne  
 of her now Majesty Anne the same Edward Scott Esq<sup>r</sup> Sheriff of said County  
 made returne thereof in these words thercon enlarged viz

There are to witte for to the Justice within mentioned that I have made  
 the within knowne before Richard Fillingham and Darby Sullivan Good  
 Lawfull men of my Baywick as the within exacteth and requireth  
 Given at Edw Scotts Shop

All which said Court also the said Debt by Chris Phillipson his atty appointed  
 to the said Court. Therefore it was ordered by the Court here that the same be  
 transpited to the latter end of the Dyale docket for the same Court but after ward  
 the said cause was continued until the then next Court

All which said next Court viz the Twenty fifth day of June in the same  
 yeare of her said Majesties Reigne Anno Dom 1708 the said Court being  
 for Dyale came the said Debt by Michael Earle there attorney and the said Debt  
 by his atty attorney having filed his plea viz

And the aforesaid Thomas Phillipson his attorney comes and  
 Defends y<sup>e</sup> force & Injury which he and prays Judgment of the Writt aforesaid because he  
 saith that true it is that the said Debt is recovred against the said Debt the Sum  
 of Three thousand five hundred pounds of Tobacco with Two hundred & four pounds  
 of Tobacco & of Suite as by the said said Court is set forth but further sayth  
 that the aforesaid Thomas his wife after wards viz upon the Twenty second day of february  
 1705 Did give an ord unto a certain Robert Smyth for three thousand seven  
 hundred & four pounds in ord to Satisfie the Debt & the above said then drawn
