The afd Deft in the plea afd. and the said Deft in his proper appearance
 to the above action and saith that he cannot gainsay the action afd ag-
 gain nor but that the sume of six hundred pounds of Tobacco and the
 sevenleen pair of mens shoes above mentioned was what he stood indebted
 to the afd plt. but saith that he hath paid to y^e afd plt. the sevenleen pair
 of mens shoes above mentioned which he prays may be allowed to him
 But that he is willing that Judgment should be entered for the above
 six hundred pounds of Tobacco and also the shoes. Therefore it is considered
 by the Court here viz. this sixteenth day of August Annoque Domini one
 thousand seven hundred and fifteen that the afd John Ellis recover ag-
 the said John Green as well the afd sume of six hundred pounds of Tobacco
 and sevenleen pair of mens shoes Debt as also the sume of two hundred
 and Nineteen pounds of Tobacco Est. by the afd plt about his suite in
 this behalfe expended and by the Court here of his afd pt adjudged and
 the said Deft in mercy e^t

AND now at this Court the same day last mentioned came the afd
 Ellis by Thomas Rowne his atty and saith that the sevenleen pair
 of shoes above mentioned he hath recovered from the afd Deft
 Philip Kennard Esq^r Duns's Journ on which writ was endorsed
 as sold viz. That she was to be found in
 the Baylwick of Wm Presbyter
