and made return thereof in these words theron endorsed as folo^{ll} viz^{is} Espi-
Corp^{or} Frisby Sher^{iff} — and the afo^{re} Def^{endant} being called came
and by James Earle his attorney appeared to the above action and
prayed liberty thereof to imparle thereto and to answer at next Court
which is granted the same day is given the pl^{aintiff} in like manner.
