Commanded it was to the Sheriff of Kent. Nath Hynson Deft. County the ninth day of April in the first year of the Reigne of his now Majesty George the third That he take George Gleaves Jun. of Kent County afo^r Wheelwright at Di^o George Gleaves Jun. of Kent County in the Province of Maryland Wheelwright if he should be found in his Baywick and him safe keep so that he have his body before his said Majesty's Justices of the next Court to be hold at our Court house in the Town of Dover in said County to answer unto Nathaniel Hynson of a plea that he render to him the sume of one pound Nineteen Shillings Sterling money which to him he oweth and unjustly detains and one thousand and forty six pounds of sound bright Dry Tobacco of the value of eighty seven Shillings and two pence Sterling money which he unjustly detains &c And that he have then and there the said writ &c. At which said next Court viz. the seventh day of June the same year afo^r the day of return of said writ
