after which comes into Court William Blay and Michael Hackel both of this County and acknowledges themselves joyntly and severally special Bayle for the afo^{re} George Cleeves Jun^r. in the afo^{re} a^{ction} and they or either of them the debt afo^{re} will pay and the cost thereon accruing if the afo^{re} p^{er} shall obtain judgment agst the said Deft. in the a^{ction} afo^{re} and the said George the condemnation afo^{re} shall not satisfy nor himselfe to the custody of the Sheriff of said County deliver or that the afo^{re} William or Michael the body of the afo^{re} George shall not render &c.
