August 26. 1715 Error Excepted James Smith

AND now at this Court this fifteenth day of Novemb<sup>r</sup>. Anno Dom<sup>o</sup> 1715 one thousand seven hundred and fifteen came the said James Smith into Court and took his corporall oath on the holy Evangelists of Almighty God and saith that his aud. ag<sup>t</sup> the afd Daniel Magee is just and true and that the said Daniel Magee was indebted to him on Ballance the sume of one pound four shillings and three pence halfe penny Currant money of the afd Province and that the Tobacco on the Bill of Cost amounting to the sume of three hundred Sixty and six pds of Tobacco he hath not rec<sup>d</sup>. AND now the said pt<sup>r</sup> by Thomas Downe his atty saith that the Law is Complied w<sup>th</sup> in such case where persons absents themselves and that the Short note representing the true cause of action was left at the last place of the Def<sup>t</sup>. abode and prays that Judgment for Attachment may be granted. Therefore it is Considered by this Court here by the same day last mentioned that for the afd sume of thirty four shillings and three pence halfe penny Currant money of this Province and three hundred Sixty and six pounds of Tobacco as also the sume of two hundred and sixty pounds of Tobacco
