Commanded it was to the Sheriff of
Kent County the Sixteenth day of Aug^r
in the Second year of the Reigne of
his now Majesty George the Third that he

take John King late of Kent County planter if he should be found
in his Bailwick and sum safe keep so that he have his body
before his Majesty's Justice of the next Court to be held at our Court
house in the Town of Chester in said County to answer unto Edward
Hamblton of a plea of Trespass on y^e Case and that he have the
aid there the said writ. All which said next Court viz^t this
fifteenth day of November the year of the day of promiss of said
writ Came William Frisby Gent High Sheriff of said County and made
return thereof in these words hereon endorsed as follow^s viz^t Copi Corpus.

W^m Frisby Sher. AND now at this Court the same day last
mentioned Came the ass^t p^t by John Johnson his atty and prays
may put in Surety for y^e p^t if in case that he Deft should appear to
the above Court and the p^t should be Call in the a^o of w^o was
granted. On which the ass^t W^m John Johnson Came into Court and
acknowledged himself as Surety for the ass^t p^t that if he should be
Call in y^e a^o of w^o that then he would pay the Cost accruing to the
Deft ass^t.

And now the ass^t p^t by his ass^t atty prays that the ass^t Deft may
be called and the ass^t Deft being called came and y^e Deft by his atty
ass^t prays that he may give Special Bayle to the Court ass^t which was
granted and that he be kept in safe Custody by the Sheriff of said
County until he shall give Special Bayle to y^e Court ass^t.
After which Mr Nathaniel Hyson and John William both of
this County Comes into Court and acknowledges themselves jointly
and severally Special Bayle for the ass^t Deft and that they or
either of them the payment of the Damages and Cost accruing on
