 Do hereby authorize and Empower you or any of you to administer the Oaths app^o by Act of Parliament to be taken instead of the Oaths of Allegiance and Supremacy the Oath of abjuration and the Oath of Justice to James Harris William Blay Lambert Wilmer and Henry Lowe Junior or any of you having taken of said Oaths are Impowered to administer the same unto the Justices and Commissioners respectively as they are nominated in the within Commission and we will that you and every of you having taken the said Oaths do severally subscribe the Test and the afo^o Oath of abjuration and for so doing this shall be your Suff^o warrant and authority hereof fail not and when you have the same so done you are to certify the same under your hands and Seals unto us in our high Court of Chancery with all convenient speed WITNESSE our Trusty & well beloved John Hart Esq. our Cap. General and Governour in Chief in and over this our Province of Maryland and the Territories thereto belonging the 15. Day of Feby in the first Year of our Dominion &c. Anno Dni 1715 J. Hart

M^r William Pott being one mentioned in the afo^o Decree doth administer the Oath of Allegiance & Supremacy the Oath of abjuration & of Customs Oath to M^r James Harris as above directed and all the Rest of the Justices & Commissioners were Sworn respectively as they are nominated in the afo^o Commission Except M^r William Comery who was not at Court. the Justices & Commiss^{rs} sitti as sold viz^t and they all signe the oath of abjuration
