And saith that he did commit the part ap with the said Mary and wholly submits himselfe to the Court on the same Therefore it is considered by the Court here by this twenty first day of March Anno Domini one Thousand Seven hundred and fifteen that the said Timothy pay the Summe of Thirty Shillings Current money Debt for Committing fornication as afo according to Act of Assembly in such Case made &c. and also the Summe of one
