The said Henry having been charged with the committing fornication with a certain Hamah Titman and thereby begott her with Child as by her oath taken in the Records of East Courts proceedings may ap^r see.

The a^d Henry comes into Court and in her proper person appears to the same and submits himselfe to the Court and saith that he is guilty of committing fornication with the a^d Hamah Titman Therefore it is considered by the Court here viz this twenty first day of March Anno Domini one Thousand seven hundred and fifteen that there be recovered for the use of the County the Summe of Six hundred pounds of Tobacco Debt against the a^d Henry Trulock for committing fornication as a^d according to Act of Assembly in such Cases made &c. and also the Summe of one hundred forty six pounds of Tobacco Coll arising on the premises

ordered that Surety be given for the fine a^d on which comes into Court Francis Bollos of this County and acknowledges himselfe indebted to his Lordship his heirs and Successors in the Summe of Six hundred pounds of Tob^o to be Levyed on his goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements Conditionally that if he do not pay the same Six hundred pounds of Tob^o to the City the ensuing Cropp it being for the fine a^d wherewith he acknowledges himselfe content

ordered by this Court here that the said Henry Trulock give Surety to keep the City harmless from the Charge that hath or shall arise to the City on Acc^t of the a^d Child.

ordered by this Court that the Master of the a^d Henry when free deliv^r the said Henry up to the Court &c

But William Brown of this County comes into Court and saith that he will take the a^d Child and clear the a^d Henry Trulock from all Charge that may arise on Account of the same The same being a Boy
