Sum of Seven hundred ninety eight pounds of Tobacco bid as aforesaid declared and is willing that Judgment should be entered for the Same and Cost thereon accruing. Therefore it is Considered by the Court here viz. this twenty second day of March Anno Domini one Thousand Seven hundred & Fifteen That the Said James Harris Plt. Recover against the Said Deft. Christopher Knight as well the Sum of Seven hundred ninety eight pounds of Tobacco Damages and also the Sum of Two hundred ninety five pounds of Tobacco Cost by the Said Plt about his Suite in this behalfe laid out and expended and by the Court here of his spent. adjudged and the Said Deft. in money &c.

Benjamin Griffiths Comended it was to the Sheriff of Kent County the sixteenth day of November. In the Second year of the reign of his now Majesty George I. That he take Christopher Knight of Kent County Planter als. D^o Christopher Knight if he shall be found in his Baywick and himselfe safe keep so that he have his body before his Said Majesties Justice of the next Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Chester in Said County Answer unto Benjamin Griffiths of a plea that he render to him y^e Sum of two hundred and fifty pounds of Merchantable Tobacco & Cash to Contain y^e Same of y^e value forty five Shillings & ten pence Sterling money of Great Brittain which he unjustly detains &c. And that he have then and there the Said writ &c. All which Said next Court viz. the twentieth day of March y^e Same year last mentioned the day of return of Said writ came William Frisby Gent. high Sheriff of Said County and made return thereof in these words. thereon made as fo^lo^ws viz. Capi Corpus y^e W^m Frisby Sher^{iff}. and a Deb being filed when Said writ issued forth and a Copy thereof served thereunto according to Act of Assembly in such Case made was as fo^lo^ws viz. Kent County to Christopher Knight of Kent County Planter
