the aff. pt. by his atty aff. prays that the aff. Deft may Conf. and the Deft being called came and in his proper person appeared to the aff. Deft and South that he cannot gain say the Quon Vass of him the Deft and that he hath had of the aff. pt. as in the aff. Quon Vass forty and that he sworth unto the aff. pt. the aff. sume of five hundred forty & six pounds of Tobacco and is willing that Judgment should be made for the same and off thereon curruing. Therefore it is ordered by the Court here on this twenty second day of March Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and fifteen That the aff. pt. James Harris recover against the said Deft Anthony Baker as well the aff. sume of five hundred forty & six pounds of Tobacco Damage and also the sume of two hundred eighty two pounds of Tobacco Costs by the said pt. about his suite in this behalfe lend out and expended and by the Court here of his aff. adjudge and the said Deft. in molyse.

John Moore vs. This being an action of Debt for the sume of four hundred & sixty ps of Tob. the Deft was returned. Indorsed Non Est Inventus.

Dom Kenlagh vs. This being an action of Trespass upon the Case the Deft was returned Indorsed Capi Corpus &c. And the Deft being called came and the Deft by Thomas

Downe his atty prays that the Deft may give ff. Bayle to the above Quon which is granted and that he be kept in safe Custody until he shall give Special Bayle &c. After which came into Court the aff. pt. in his proper person and South that the Quon aff. between them is agreed. and prays it may be so entered and that all proceedings therein cease.

Thomas Irishan vs. This being an action of Trespass upon the Case the Deft was returned Indorsed viz Non Est Inventus &c.
