Cornelius Harentun
vs
William Jones

Commanded it was to the Sheriff of Kent County
the sixteenth day of November in the
second year of the Reigne of his now Majesty
George the 3^d. That he take William Jones of
Kent County Planter as Defendant in a Plea
of Maryland if he should be found in his Baywick and him safe keep so that
he have his body before his said Majesty's Justice of the next Court to be
held at our Court house in the Town of Puster in said County to answer
unto Cornelius Harentun by y^e name of Cornelius Harentun of Baltimore
County Carpenter of a plea that he render to him y^e full sum & just quantity
of one thousand eight & thirty pounds of good sound Merchantable life
Tobacco in Cash to contain y^e same of y^e value of four pounds Six Shillings
& Six pence Sterling money of Great Brittain which he unjustly detains
&c. And that he have then and there the said writ. All which said

next Court on the twentieth day of March the same year last mentioned
the day of return of sd writ came William Frisby Gent High Sheriff of
said County and made return thereof in these words thereon to wit
as follows. Capi Corpus Et W^m Frisby Sh^r. And the said pt being not
an inhabitant of this County rule is given that Surety for the D^e pt be put
in to ans^r y^e D^eft his Cost if the D^e pt should be non suited in y^e aⁿ action
after which came into Court M^r Thomas Bowne and M^r William Frisby
both of this County and acknowledged themselves joyntly and severally
Surety for the said pt. in the aⁿ action and the Cost arising on the same
if in case the said D^eft shall appear to the same and non suite the pt
in the same aⁿ action that if the aⁿ pt should not pay y^e same Cost that
they or either of them will do it for him. After which the D^e pt by
Thomas Bowne his atty prayd that the said D^eft may give Special
Bayle to the above aⁿ action which is granted and that William Frisby Gent
High Sheriff of said County keep the aⁿ D^eft in safe Custody until he
shall give Special Bayle to the above aⁿ action. After which came into
Court Thomas Shackston of this County and acknowledged himselfe as
Special Bayle to the aⁿ aⁿ action and undertook the payment of the D^eft
aⁿ Cost thereon arising if it should happen that the said pt
should obtain Judgment against the said D^eft. in the aⁿ aⁿ action of D^eft.
