of forty five Shillings and ten pence. Here money at or upon the
tenth day of November next ensuing of date of the said writing
obligatory yet the aforesaid Thomas Joye altho' often required of aforesaid
two hundred and fifty pounds of Job unto the said Thomas Smyth
hath not rendered nor paid nor Cause to be rendered or paid but the
same to render or pay the said Thomas Joye hitherto hath denied
and yet denyeth unjustly detains of damage of the said Thomas
Smyth four pounds long shillings and pence and thorough his
bring Suite &c. **AND** the said Debt being called in and the said Plaintiff by his aforesaid
attorney pray that the said Debt may give aforesaid Bayle to the aforesaid action which
is granted and that he be kept in safe Custody until he shall give aforesaid
Bayle to the aforesaid action. After which Comes into Court Edward
Blackiston of said County and acknowledges himself a special Bayle
in the aforesaid action and doth undertake for the said Thomas Joye the
payment of the Debt aforesaid and all thereon accruing if it should hap-
pen that the said Plaintiff should obtain Judgment against the said
Debt in the said action of Debt and the said Debt. The Condemna-
tion aforesaid shall not suffice nor himselfe to the Custody of the Sheriff of
said County deliver or that the said Edward the body of the said
Thomas shall not render &c. **AND** the said Thomas Came into
Court and in his proper person appeared to the above action and
saith that he cannot gainsay the action aforesaid of him the said Plaintiff
but that the writing obligatory above mentioned is his Act &c.
deed and that he doth own unto the said Plaintiff the Sum aforesaid and is
willing that Judgment should be entered for the same and all
thereon accruing **WHEREUPON** it is **CONSIDERED** by the Court
here on this twenty second day of March Anno Domini one.
