William Frisby Esq. High Sheriff of Said County, keep the afo James Doarn in safe custody until he shall give security as afo
afterwards the same James Doarn came into Court and acknowledged himself
indebted to his Lordship his honest Successors in the Sum of 100
pounds Sterl. to be levied on his goods and Chattells Lands and Tenemts
Conditionally that if he shall not make his personal appearance at
the next Court and then and there to answer unto what shall be object
ed against him on his Lordships behalfe and in the mean time to
be of good behaviour &c. wherewith he acknowledges himself to
be content.

Likewise came into Court Nathaniel Pearce and William Jones
of this County and acknowledged themselves indebted to his Lordship
his honest Successors in the Sum of 50 pounds Sterl. each to be
levied on their goods and Chattells Lands and Tenements Conditionally
that if the said James Doarn shall not make his personal appearance
at the next Court and to answer as afo wherewith they acknowledge
themselves to be therewith content.

His Majesty's Recognizance in the Sum of 50 Sterl. his Sureties
John Ellis and Samuel Parsons in the Sum of
Edward Williams 5 Sterl. each. The same is by this Court continued
until next Court.

this Court ordered by this Court that the same Recognizance be

ten pounds Sterl. for his appearance to this Court as an Ord. against
