The same James being presented by the Grand Jury which is as follows viz. W^{ch} of the Grand Jury for the body of Kent County do present James Dunnavan for stealing of one Silver bodkin of goods of Edward Shidmore. Evidence Peter Dobular and Robert Devinish value two Shillings and six pence Sterl. Billa vera of Simon Wilmer for man. The said James being called came and in his proper person appeared at the bar and

swore that he cannot deny but that he is guilty as above stated and submits himself to the Court on the same. Therefore it is considered by the Court here by this twenty second day of March Anno

Domini 1715 that the said James have on his bare back seven loon stripes till the blood appear for committing the offence aforesaid and also pay the same of four hundred and ten pounds of Tobacco Coll arising on the premises

and it is likewise considered by this Court here by the same day last mentioned that William Frisby Gent High Sheriff of said County take the said James to the public whipping post and receive as in the judgment aforesaid and when executed the same to bring him into Court.

After which the same day last mentioned came the said Sheriff with the said James and made return of his precept in all things forced and executed by W^m Frisby Sheriff

ordered by the Court here that the said James give Surety to pay the fees arising on the premises aforesaid. The said James having no goods or Chattels & no person being willing to be Surety for him it is ordered by the Court here that the said James be sold to pay the four fold amounting to eight Shillings Sterl and the bodkin to be delivered to the said Edward Shidmore and also to pay the Coll in the judgment above of Michael Byrne of this County comes into Court and swears that he will take the said James and pay the four fold & fees aforesaid if this Court think fit he should have for six months ordered by this Court here that the said James Dunnavan serve Michael Byrne the space of six months from this day to be completed for the consideration of
