Pryor esq^r. after which Comes into Court the ap^{pe} Ellenor and acknowledged herselfe indebted to his Lordship his hono^r in the Summe of tenne pounds Sterl. to be Levoyed on her goods & Chattells Lands & Tenements Conditionally that if she do not make her personall ap^{pe} at the next Court to be held for this County & there and there to answer into a certain presentment found agst her by the Grand Jury &c. and in the mean time to be of good behaviour &c. where with she acknowledges herselfe Content

Likewise Came into Court James Brower of this County and acknowledged himselfe indebted to his Lordship his hono^r in the Summe of tenne pounds Sterl. to be Levoyed on his goods & Chattells Lands & Tenements Conditionally that if the above said Ellenor Kendall do not make her personall ap^{pe} at the next Court to be held for this County & there to answer into a certain presentment found agst her by the Grand Jury &c. and in the mean time to be of good behaviour &c. where with he acknowledges himselfe Content

The ap^{pe} Mary being Serv^{ant} to M^r. William Bay and

Mary Savonder The being lately delivered of a base born Child Comes into Court and ap^{pe} to the same at the Barre ordered by this Court here that the ap^{pe} Mary prove the Begittor the same Mary deny and saith that she will not declare on Oath who was the Begittor of the same nor will not satisfie the Court concerning the same. but saith that she was lately delivered of a Child and that she did Commit fornication in Begitting the same she being not married and the Child is now dead and submits herselfe to the Court on the same. Therefore it is Considered by the Court

here by this twenty third day of March Anno Domini one Thousand Seven hundred and fifteen. That the ap^{pe} Mary Savonder have on her bare back Thirty nine lashes on her bare back till the blood ap^{pe} for Committing the offense of fornication & and also pay the Summe of one hundred and twenty nine pounds of Tobacco Cost arising on the same to the officers of this Court Likewise it is Considered by the Court here by the same day last mentioned that William Frisby Gent High Sheriff of said County take the ap^{pe} Mary Savonder to the public whipping Post and to Rowes as in the Judgment
